

Rules for Yorkshire Ladies Inter County Competitions. Amended 2022

Champion of Champions: To enter this competition you must have won your club's 4 bowl singles the previous season. It shall be a single-handed game consisting of 4 bowls, 21 shots and will be played on selected dates and greens. The Semi-final and Final will be played on one day at Northallerton B.C. Or on a neutral green selected by the Competition Secretary.

Janet Harrow: is an inter-club competition for a shield; 3 Triples, 3 Bowls, 18 ends. Each club shall be represented by 9 players forming 3 rinks who may be substituted in the subsequent rounds should an original player not be available.

At the end of the game each teams' rink scores will be added together, should the score be level after 18 ends have been played, the Captains shall toss a coin and the winner shall decide whether or not her team shall deliver the jack. All three rinks will play the extra end. Highest score wins. The Final shall be played on a neutral green as decided by the Competition Secretary.

Ann Wilkinson: is an inter-club competition for a Rose Bowl; double rinks, 8 players, 2 bowls, 18 ends. Each club shall be represented by 8 players forming 2 rinks, any member of the team may be substituted in the subsequent rounds should an original player not be available.

At the end of the game each teams' rink scores will be added together, should the score be level after 18 ends have been played, the Captains shall toss a coin and the winner shall decide whether or not her team shall deliver the jack. Both rinks will play the extra end. Highest score wins. The Final shall be played on a neutral green as decided by the Competition Secretary.

Substitutes for Janet Harrow and Ann Wilkinson: After the commencement of a team game in any round, in the event of illness or accident, only one substitute per rink will be allowed. Players in the rink may then be adjusted accordingly. No further changes to that rink will be allowed. In the event of another player in the same rink having to leave the game, play in that rink will stop and the score will be held to the end of the game. If no reserves are available to substitute, play will halt and the rink score will be held to the end of the game.

Any club wishing to enter more than one team in the Janet Harrow and Ann Wilkinson may do so providing a list of players for each squad is received by the Competition Secretary prior to the draw being made.

Benevolent Triples: Each game shall consist of 3 players, 2 bowls and 15 ends. This is a knockout competition to be played to a final in one or two days on greens selected by the Competition Secretary. The Final will be played on County Finals Day.

Over 55's Singles: 4 bowls, 21 shots. Played on a home and away basis up to the Final which will be played on County Finals Day.

Over 55's Pairs: 4 bowls, 18 ends. Played by 2 members of the same club on a home and away basis up to the Final which will be played on County Finals Day.

If in any round played on a home and away basis, the opponent has to travel more than 160 miles round trip they may ask for a neutral green that the challenger shall arrange. This green must be affiliated to Y.B.A.
