Tenure: 1 Year - This is a voluntary position.

Role Summary

This is the highest honour a player can hold within the County. The primary role of the President is to be the figurehead and main representative for all aspects of Bowls Yorkshire that come under the banner of YBA, during her period in office.

Working with YBA Executive Committee, including County Administrator, Ladies' Secretary, Team Manager, the Vice President, plus those on other Committees as required.

Responsibilities

Attend all YBA Ladies' matches

Attend Men's matches and Men's Finals Day where possible

Attend and support John's Trophy and Walker Cup Teams where possible

Attend as many of County Quarter and Semi-finals as possible

Attend County Finals Day and present awards to recipients

Arrange County President's day

Attend County Ladies' Luncheon, present trophies

Attend YBA Executive Committee meetings and AGM

Attend Bowls England Championships to support the players. Ensuring attendance for the player's badge presentation and Trophy (if won)

Attend Bowls England Champions' Dinner if Yorkshire winners

Ensure that YBA standards and protocols are upheld

Wear appropriate uniform when on duty

Supply gifts and prizes when relevant

Choose location for Ladies' County Tour and work with Tour Manager for its success
